

# CPSC 444 Tutorial: Video 2

## Description:

---

- In this tutorial you will learn about the basics of video editing with Adobe Premier. Within your group, you will create a 1 min video, to present to the class, using some of the footage you collected in the Video I tutorial.

## Materials:

- Video footage from Video 1 tutorial (your mini DV tape)
- 1-2 pairs of headphones
- **Optional:** an external storage device
- **Optional:** music (mp3s, WAV, etc), for use in your edited video

## Objectives:

- By the end of the tutorial, you will be able to use Adobe Premier to:
  - Import clips
  - Cut and move clips
  - Add a title
  - Add a transition
  - Add audio to video
  - Export Clips

## Deliverables:

- At the end of the lab, each group must hand in their completed video. This is an unmarked deliverable..

## Tentative Schedule:

---

- Quiz + discussion (~15 min)
- Video importing (~15 min)
  - Choose 1 of the videos you shot during the Video 1 tutorial. In this tutorial, you will produce a 1-minute video from this footage.
  - The TA will provide instruction on how to import your video in Adobe Premier.
    - **IMPORTANT** Because your own file space is limited, you should import the video to your machine's hard drive. The c:/temp folder should be writable. Alternatively, use an external storage device.
- Video Editing
  - The TA will give a short demonstration on how to edit video in Adobe Premier (~15 min)
  - Editing: create the video you designed in the brainstorming phase (~50 min)
  - Exporting: output the video; use a low internet quality (high compression) (~5 min)
- Playback of videos (~10 min)
  - each team will show their video, one at a time
  - fill out evaluation sheets for each video you see
- Return evaluation sheets to the appropriate groups before leaving the tutorial
