No Pictures ▶ Liust Know Person X Wrote This Review "X did Y" not enough aggressively replace words with illustrations sometimes true, sometimes false must say why previous work doesn't solve your problem! most slides should have a nicture don't get fixated, try not to take it personally what limitations of theirs does your approach fix? ▶ Deadly Detail Dump ▶ Ignore Review and Resubmit Unchanged Full Coverage Or Bust often will get same reviewer, who will be irritated how allowed only after what and why · cannot fit all details from paper motivation: why should I care talk as advertising, communicate big picture It's The Writing Not The Work overview: what did you do sometimes true: bad writing can doom good work details: how did you do it converse: good writing may save borderline work Jargon Attack sometimes false: weak work all too common avoid where you can many people reinvent wheel define before using some people make worse wheels than previous ones

 nutrue culture of internal critique
