Reference letters

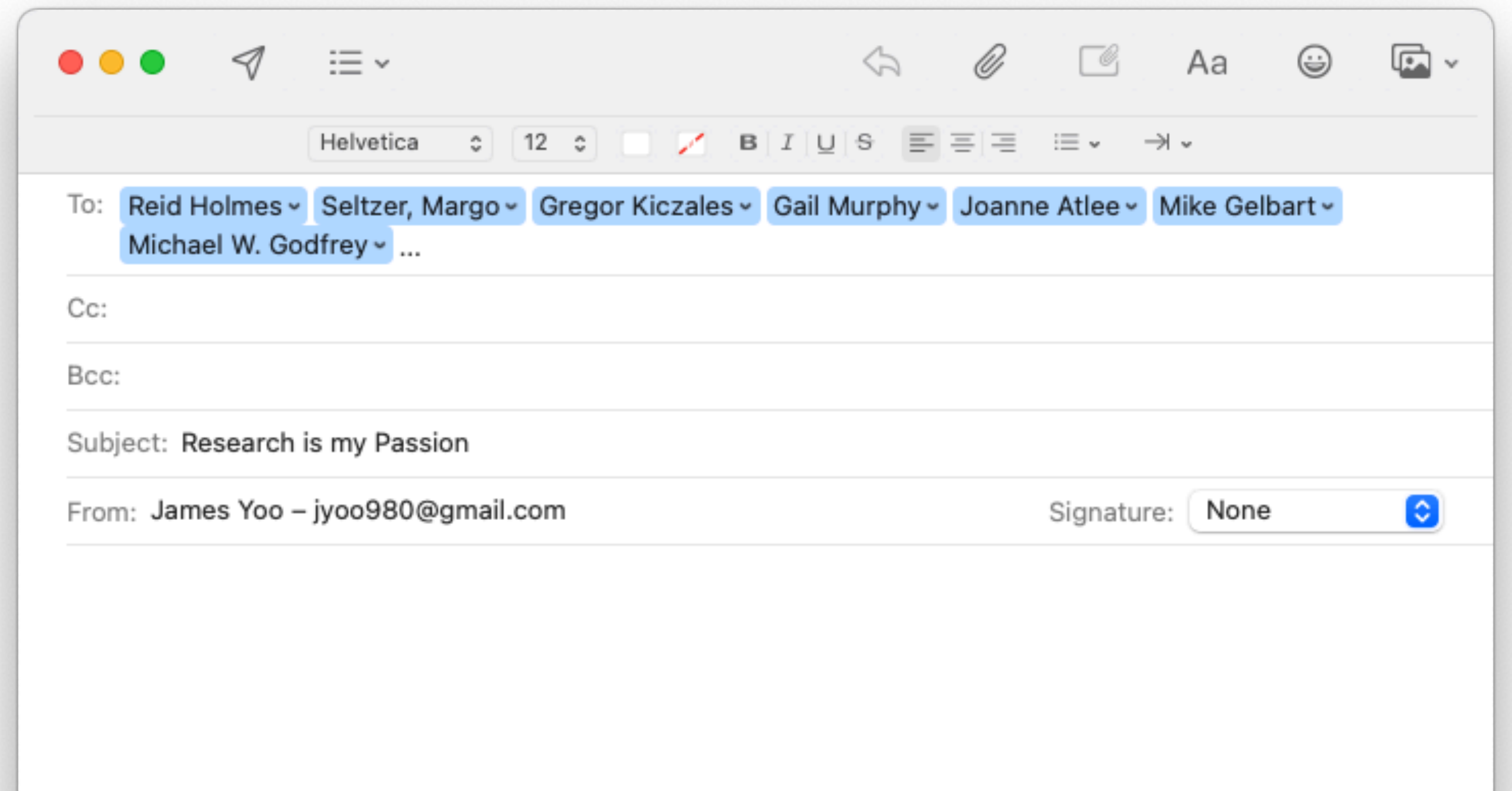
- Ask professors you *barely* know

The statement of intent (Part 1)

- Practice your fiction skills!
